These budget components are reviewed, discussed and refined into the Superintendent's Recommended Budget. The anticipated date for the first presentation of the Superintendent's recommended budget is scheduled for February 23, 2015. This version of the budget will still contain many estimates and approximations that will be under review and a work in progress until April 2015.

Lastly, as we endure the cold freezing temperatures and potential snow storms we are eagerly awaiting weather that will not impact school delays and closings.
