#### MR. DI GRANDI'S DISSERTATION

Conferences went very well and I appreciate the conversations between home and school. It is imperative that we continue to work together and communicate for OUR children. The new report card format received a good overall response. Some parents asked for a +/- clarification system and I will pass that information along to the appropriate people, along with a few other enhancements some suggested.

READING / LITERACY - Please continue to read with your son or daughter. Having conversations about books, heading to the public library, checking Barnes & Noble or updating a magazine subscription are just a few ways to keep the reading fire burning!! Remember to keep it fun and keep it frequent!!

MATH / NUMERACY - Mental math is so important! Please continue to work with your son or daughter to estimate and use mental math - time, distance, tax, find a way to infuse math into a conversation...scores, batting average, stocks; Numbers are everywhere!

## STUDENT SAFETY CONCERNS

Over the last few weeks I have noticed the trend, particularly for our students in grades 3-5, of parents picking up students as early as 2:45 p.m. I realize the students are usually at recess at this time, but it has caused some confusion on the playground. Therefore, to enhance the supervision of all students at recess, I am asking that students being picked up early remain with the grade-level study hall teacher on that day. This prevents multiple calls to the playground to obtain a student who is leaving early and will improve the overall safety of our students in many ways. The students who remain inside with a study hall teacher will have an opportunity to complete work or read silently.

On the topic of student safety, I have also noticed a growing contingency of students and parents in the main lobby starting at approximately 8:30 a.m. Since students are not released to their classrooms until 8:50 due to supervision issues, I am asking that students and parents not arrive prior to 8:45 a.m.

Starting Monday, December 5<sup>th</sup>, I am asking anyone arriving prior to 8:50 a.m. sit in the All-Purpose Room. This will prevent the congestion hazard in our main lobby and allow for the unencumbered movement of custodians, teachers, food services personnel, and WCSD personnel who complete work prior to school.

Thank you for your assistance with these requests. Though these items might seem minor, they truly enhance the safety of our school for all.

In order to stay involved and aware of the happenings at Fishkill Plains, the Fishkill Plains PTA is offering an e-mail update service through Google groups. Your e-mail address will be used only by the PTA and not shared with any other outside parties.

## SCHOOL LEADERSHIP TEAM

The SLT, comprised of teachers, parents, and the Principal have been approved for their 2011-2012 plan. This year the group has decided to purchase grade level, grade/age appropriate books on Bullying. The goal is to have teachers infuse bullying strategies and awareness through Literacy. For Bully Awareness Week (November 14-18<sup>th</sup>) students signed an Anti-Bullying Pledge and wore blue on Friday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, to coincide with our theme, "Bullying Makes Me Blue!" Keep a look out for a Bullying Survey that will be online shortly for you and your child to complete.
