## MR. DI GRANDI'S DISSERTATION

Parents have inquired as to the process for 2012-2013 student placements. Taking into account teacher feedback and a detailed student rubric, which outlines academic performance, work habits, organization, and social needs, classes will be formed which best create educational equity.

My goal is to always balance classrooms, in an educationally equitable manner, to provide for the best learning opportunities for all students. The goal of our teachers, regardless of the class, is to differentiate the assignments provided to students, to best challenge and meet their needs. This happens in each and every class and is something we continually reflect upon and discuss as educators, especially with the new Common Core Standards being implemented at each grade level.

I am excited to report that next school year we will have one section of inclusion at each grade level, from K-5. With that in mind, it is likely that your son/daughter will be in an inclusion class, once, if not twice, in their K-5 time at Fishkill Plains. If this has not occurred yet, it might next year or the year after. Inclusion classes challenging and provide math science assignments, homework that is not too easy, and an environment that will continually challenge each student in order to remain engaged, while at the same time offering an opportunity to develop greater social and emotional learners; a predictor of future success by many accounts.
