**BOARD GOAL’S FOR THE**  
**2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR**

November 18, 2014

At the Board of Education meeting of November 17, 2014 the following Board Goal’s were adopted in their entirety:

1.)	Achieve the 10 “End Results” from the District’s Strategic Plan selected as the focus for the 2014-2015 school year at a level of at least ‘Proficient’.
2.)	Develop a plan, to be implemented in the 2015-2016 school year and aligned to the District’s Strategic Plan, which will increase enrichment and STEM opportunities at the K-6 level.
3.)	Increase the number of students completing honors, advance level, and AP courses; increase the number of students graduating with distinction and with honors; and increase the overall district graduation rate by 2%.

**Strategy 1-1**

A system is in place that all current and future employees understand the District’s mission, core values and strategic objectives and how their role contributes to them.

**Strategy 1-4**

A system is in place to ensure all employees have equal access to District communication.

**Strategy 2-1,2, & 3**

A process to identify, create, select, implement and evaluate prototype programs is established to support student achievement of the strategic objectives. A process to sustain

and replicate prototype programs supports student achievement of the strategic objectives. Data and research is utilized to assess the effectiveness of current district programs.

**Strategy 2-4**

The school community utilizes technology and resources to create and support goal setting and individual learning experiences from kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

**Strategy 3-2**

The BOE, administration and staff model, apply and are accountable to standards that are fundamental prerequisites to effective collaboration.

A process exists to align the talents and resourcefulness of current employees in order to achieve the strategic objectives.
