

DISTRICT VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION

To vote in budget and school board elections, you must be a U.S. citizen, 18 years or older, a district resident for 30 days or more, and registered to vote.

If you have voted in a Wappingers Central School District election in the last four years, you are registered.

If you are registered for general (political) elections in Dutchess County, you may vote in school district elections.

To Register:

Registration day will be publicized in the Southern Dutchess News and the Poughkeepsie Journal. It usually takes place 7-14 days before the vote.

You may register any Wednesday during the school day, between 9 am-3 pm, throughout the school year at the following schools: Vassar Road Elementary School, Wappingers Falls Junior High School, Fishkill Elementary School, Fishkill Plains Elementary School, Gayhead Elementary School and Myers Corners Elementary School.

You would need to register in the school in which you would vote.

NOTE: You will NOT be able to vote if you are not registered with the school district OR registered for general elections BEFORE Election Day itself.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

District residents may vote by absentee ballots if they are to be out of the district on election day. An application for the absentee ballot may be obtained by mail or in person from the District Clerk. Once the application is received then the ballot can be given. The ballot must be received no later than 5 pm the date of the vote. For more details call the District Clerk at 845-298-5000, ext. 40145 or ext. 40124 between 8 am -5 pm.
