# **Lego Robotics Camp**

For students entering grades 4-8

Session 1:Monday, June 30 – Thursday, July 3Time:9:00 am-2:00 pmSession 2:Monday, July 21 – Friday, July 25Time:9:00 am-1:00 pm

**Location:** Wappingers JHS, Room M-12

**Cost:** \$125 per session

This class is a chance for students to take mathematical formulas and develop the programming skills needed to direct a robot to perform a task in the real world. The robots are programmed to move, react, or make sounds in order to solve challenges. Students will work in teams of 2-3 as they construct up to 4 distinct robots of their own design which are driven by a microcontroller. Students can sign up for one or both sessions and can continue work from session I in session II. All robots are based on LEGO Mindstorms NXT 2.0. Register early...classes fill quickly! LIMIT 20 STUDENTS per session.
