The 2017-2018 budget that was approved by you, the voters, included specific funding to promote and enhance our elementary Science Curriculum. The teachers who participated in this great endeavor are to be highly commended for their efforts, and more importantly, for a high-quality product for all of our Kindergarten – Grade 6 teachers. This information will be utilized during their teaching of Science, as well as integrated as part of the English Language Arts (ELA) instructional program. Most important is that our curriculum is locally-created to best meet the needs of all WCSD students.

WCSD continues to take on many great projects that ultimately benefit our students and the entire learning community as a whole. Some of these exciting projects include a new press box and athletic field for Roy C. Ketcham High School, as well as a new athletic field and beautifully remodeled cafeteria for John Jay Senior High School. We are also extremely satisfied with the paving that was completed in several of the parking lots, as well as new windows at Wappingers Junior High School. All elementary students, along with all parochial students, are scheduled for the second tier schedule arriving and leaving together on the bus from their home community elementary school.
