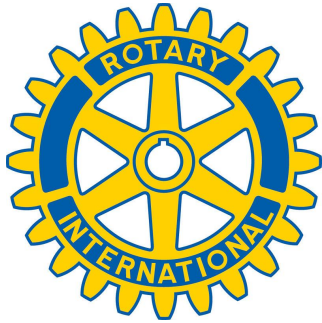

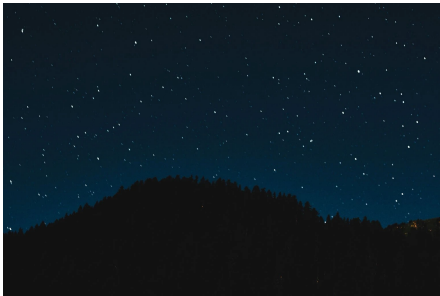
## Mrs. King Presents

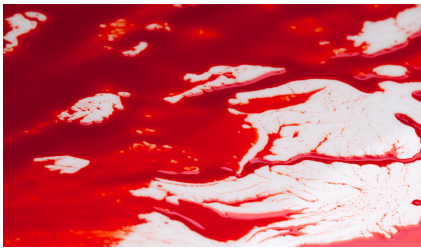


## Climax

## TV News

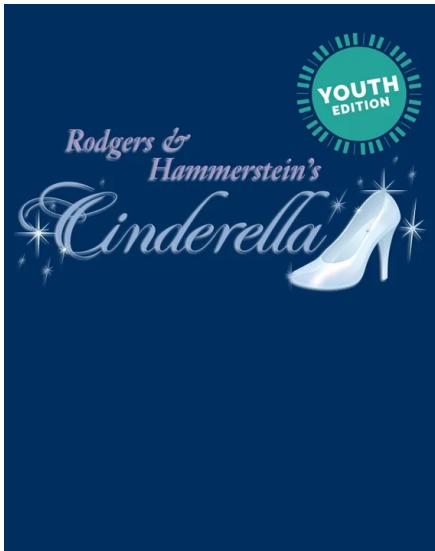
