<u>DRESS CODE</u>: Students are expected to be dressed and groomed in an appropriate manner. The following are inappropriate and are prohibited in school:

- Clothing that is distractible, such as garments that inappropriately expose body parts or articles of undergarments while standing, sitting, walking or participating in normal school activities are not permitted. This means: no short shorts, no short dresses/skirts, no low-cut shirts, skin tight fitted clothing, no spaghetti strap tops, no halter tops and no see-through or mesh garments.
- Shoes, sandals and sneakers are to be worn properly laced and safely secured to the feet. Flip flops and sport sandals are not permitted to be worn due to safety issues in corridors, stairwells and classrooms.
- Any dress or appearance which advocates discrimination or denigrates others based upon race, color, creed, religion, national origin, gender, sexual orientation or disability are not permitted.
- Clothing or jewelry that supports or promotes profanity, the consumption of alcohol, drugs, and/or tobacco, sexually suggestive phrases, or any other inappropriate phrases or symbols are not permitted.
- All head gear including hats, sunglasses, bandanas, sweatshirt hoods, are not
 permitted while in the school building. Head covering is reserved for religious and
 health and safety reasons only.

Students who do not follow the dress code will be referred to administration.
