CELEBRATE NOVEMBER'S NATIONAL DAYS:

Cupcakes were originally baked in heavy pottery cups. Today, some bakers still use individual ramekins, small coffee mugs, larger teacups, or other small ovenproof pottery-type dishes for baking their cupcakes.

Today, cupcakes are an art form. Bakers create elaborate decorations and displays utilizing a variety of ingredients. Whether they're the centerpiece of a wedding, birthday, or anniversary, cupcakes satisfy everyone's sweet tooth.
