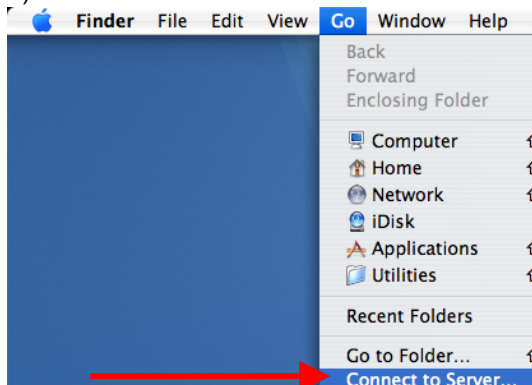

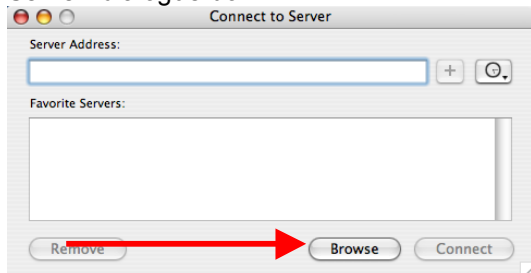
Before File Sharing, **SAVE** your work, and **CLOSE** your files!



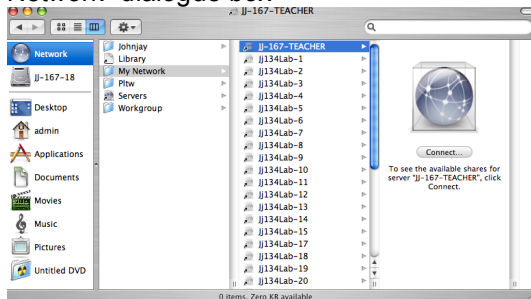
1) Choose **GO** → **CONNECT TO SERVER**



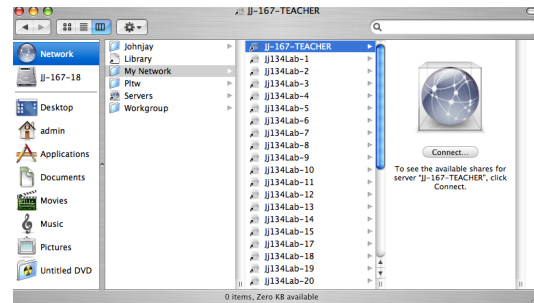
2) Choose **BROWSE** in the “Connect to Server” dialogue box



3) Choose **MY NETWORK** from the “My Network” dialogue box



4) Choose **JJ-167-TEACHER** from the list and then choose **CONNECT**

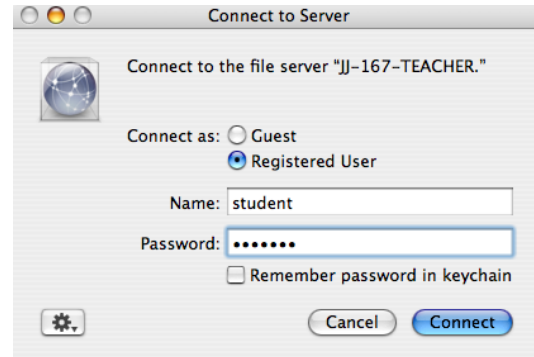


5) In the “Connect to Server” dialogue box, type:

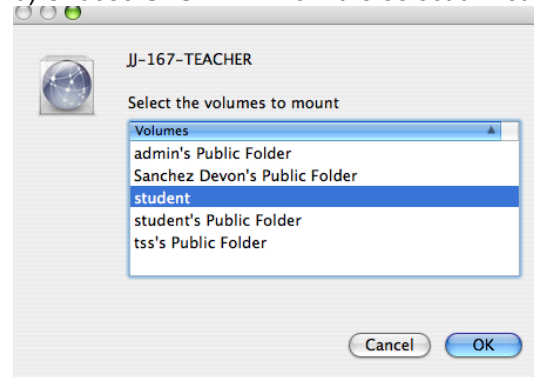

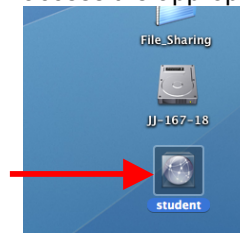
-Then choose **CONNECT**



6) Choose **STUDENT** from the selection list.



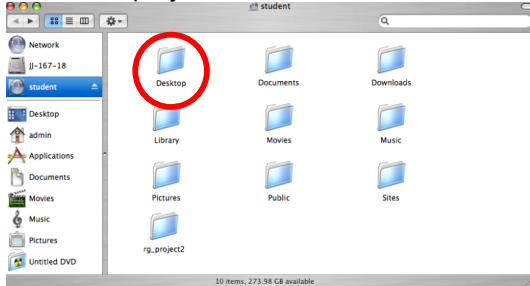
7) The Network Logo now appears on your desktop. **CLICK** the network logo icon to access the appropriate folders.
