Go to Quia.com/web. Enter your username and password FOR THIS CLASS. If you have a username and password for a previous class, it will not work for Spanish 4. You will be directed to your profile. If you click on "View" next to our class name you will see all of the assignments. If you click on our class name, you will see a list of all the assignments you have completed and the grade for each. MAKE SURE THAT YOU TRY YOUR QUIA ACCOUNT SOON TO MAKE SURE IT WORKS. Remember to sign into the correct class using the correct username and password. If you have any problems, please email me immediately.

You have been assigned a total of 15 quizzes to take. You are able to take the quizzes in any order and as many times as you wish. Use these tries to learn from your mistakes. Use your class notes from Spanish 3 and 2 to help guide you. I have also included a number of helpful websites on our class webpage to help you in clarifying any confusion about almost any Spanish grammar concept. If after several tries, you still don't understand something about a concept, just write down a question and bring it with you on the first day of class.
