The grid above is a sample of the template that you will find in Google Drive. You may NOT use this paper template to do your assignment as paper documents will NOT be accepted.

Logging into and using Google docs through your Wappingers account.

1. Go to drive.google.com
2. your username follows this format:
 firstname.lastname@wcsdny.org
3. your initial password is: g00glem3 **(If you have already created your password you may skip to step 6.)**
4. enter the funny letters as you see them to verify that you are an actual person ;-)
5. create your new password: Your password will be your Firstname (capitalize the first letter) followed by your Student ID number. Example: Nancy1234
6. Add a template app or any other app:
 - a. Click Create, then click “connect more apps”, then enter “template” on the search bar.
 - b. Choose the one called “Create from template-Drive” (You will need this to get the Summer Assignment template)
 - c. You can also add a video template “wevideo”. This will help you uploading/creating videos
7. Create a new folder. Go to “Create” or “New”, then “Folder”. Name it with your Full Name-Summer Assignment. (Ex. Nancy Beiner-Summer Assignment)
8. Share the folder with me at nancy.beiner@wcsdny.org (This will ensure that everything that you put in this folder will be shared with me)
9. To view the templates click on “Create”, then “Create from Template” and notice that you will have all the templates created by Wappingers School District. Scroll down or search for the one that you want to use. Click on “Use this template”
10. Add this template to the folder that you created.
11. Follow the directions on the top of the Summer Assignment template carefully.
12. Create a Google doc for each entry. Label it with the number on the box of the template that corresponds to that activity and make sure that you add ALL of your work to the Folder that you created and shared in step 7.

You may only do the number of tasks available in each box. If you think of alternate activities, you must get my approval first. I will let you know which ones you can substitute.
