Dear WCSD Families,

We are continuing to register for our athletic programs this fall through the online system called FamilyID (www.familyid.com). There will be **two forms** to fill out to complete the process of registering for a sport. The first, **Sports Registration**, provides a place for you to indicate your athlete's interest in playing sports and allow the health office to review your athlete's physical several months before the start of the next season. The second, **Final Confirmation Form**, will open exactly 30 days prior to the start of the season.

PLEASE NOTE: Your athlete will not be cleared to play without a valid physical on file, a completed Sports Registration and an approved Final Confirmation Form. Both forms should be submitted through FamilyID.

# Sports Registration for High School Sports will be open on May 23th to August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

# Final Confirmation Form will be open on July 15<sup>th</sup> to August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

\*Late registrants could run the risk of not being able to tryout in time because each student needs to go through the same clearance process.

Follow these steps:

1. To find your program, click on the link provided above and select the registration form under the word Programs.

- 2. Next click on the green Register Now button. If this is your first time using FamilyID, click on the green Create Account. Click Log In, if you already have a FamilyID account.
- 3. Create your secure FamilyID account by entering the account owner's First and Last names (parent/guardian), E-mail address and password. Select I Agree to the FamilyID Terms of Service. Click Create Account.
- 4. You will receive an email with a link to activate your new account. (If you don't see the email, check your E-mail filters (spam, junk, etc.).
- 5. Click on the link in your activation E-mail, which will log you in to FamilyID.com
- 6. Once in the registration form, complete the information requested. All fields with a red\* are required to have an answer.
- 7. Click the Save & Continue button when your form is complete.
- 8. Review your registration summary.
- 9. Click the green Submit button. After selecting 'Submit', the registration will be complete. You will receive a completion email from FamilyID confirming your registration.

At any time, you may log in at www.familyid.com to update your information and to check your registration(s). To view a completed registration, select the 'Registration' tab on the blue bar.
