Parents of 2019-2020 AP Students:

The AP Program is making some improvements to their program beginning this fall. We are sending this letter out now to give families time to plan.

AP teachers have been working with their students to have them “join” their class through College Board by using a code provided by their teacher. This information will be used to prepare new personalized labels that they will use on AP Exams.

More importantly, “joining” a class provides students access to a set of new resources. College Board has specifically designed these for AP students to help them with practice opportunities and feedback throughout the year.

Another change involves when students need to register and pay for their exams in the fall. Please note that the 2020 AP Exam fee remains \$95. **College Board now requires that fees be collected during the fall registration period, between October 21, 2019 – November 8, 2019.**

This year the College Board has raised the late registration and cancellation fee to \$40. Exams ordered after the November 8 deadline (*between November 16, 2019-February 28, 2020*) will include the \$40 late registration fee. Exams that are canceled after February 28, 2020, will have a \$40 cancellation fee (Meaning \$55 of the \$95 fee would be returned to you). **Please note: College Board will not provide refunds after February 28, 2020.**

Your child’s AP teacher will provide registration information, and it will also be available on the school website at bit.ly/WCSDCollegeBoardRegistration.
