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### OUR COMMUNITY

The Wappingers Central School District is one of the largest school districts in New York State with an enrollment of over 12,000 students. The District covers 110 square miles in southern Dutchess County and serves a residential suburban community with a population of approximately 75,000. A large percentage of our residents are college graduates engaged in professional careers. Our community is rich in retail and professional employment opportunities. IBM Corporation is a major local employer, along with other computer-related and "high tech" manufacturing companies. New York City is within commuting distance. Vassar College, Marist College, and Dutchess Community College are located in nearby Poughkeepsie. Other institutions of higher learning in the area include: Bard College, Mount Saint Mary College, the State University of New York at New Paltz, and the Culinary Institute of America.

### OUR FACULTY

Ninety-five percent of district faculty hold a Master's degree or higher and nearly fifty percent have ten or more years of teaching experience. The student-to-teacher ratio at Ketcham is approximately 15:1.

Ketcham students benefit from a rich curriculum including courses in art, business, family and consumer science, health, English Language Arts, mathematics, music, physical education, science, social studies, technology, and world languages (French, Italian and Spanish).

The Class of 2022 had 386 graduates. 85% continued their formal education full time, 48% enrolled in four year colleges and universities, 38% enrolled in two-year colleges, and 1% in vocational schools. Of the other graduates, 1% enlisted in the military and 9% entered the workforce. There were nine recipients of the New York State Regents Scholarship for Academic Excellence. Recent graduates were accepted by some of the nation's most prestigious colleges and universities. Locally, RCK graduates attended Dutchess Community College, Marist College, Mount Saint Mary College, SUNY New Paltz, Vassar College, and the Culinary Institute of America.

### Diploma Summary - Class of 2022

Of the 386 graduating seniors, 62% percent received Regents Diplomas with Advanced Designation, 37% received Regents Diplomas and 1% received CDOS or other certification.
