To enroll, enter Google through your student's gmail account. There should be a group of nine dots in the right hand corner of the screen. Click on those, and you should see the Classroom app. **My 5th grade music code is t2tcucs. Please let me know if you have any trouble getting enrolled in the class.

**I will have office hours every day between 9-10am.** During those times, I will be available to answer any questions you have, via email, telephone, or Google Meet/Hangout.
