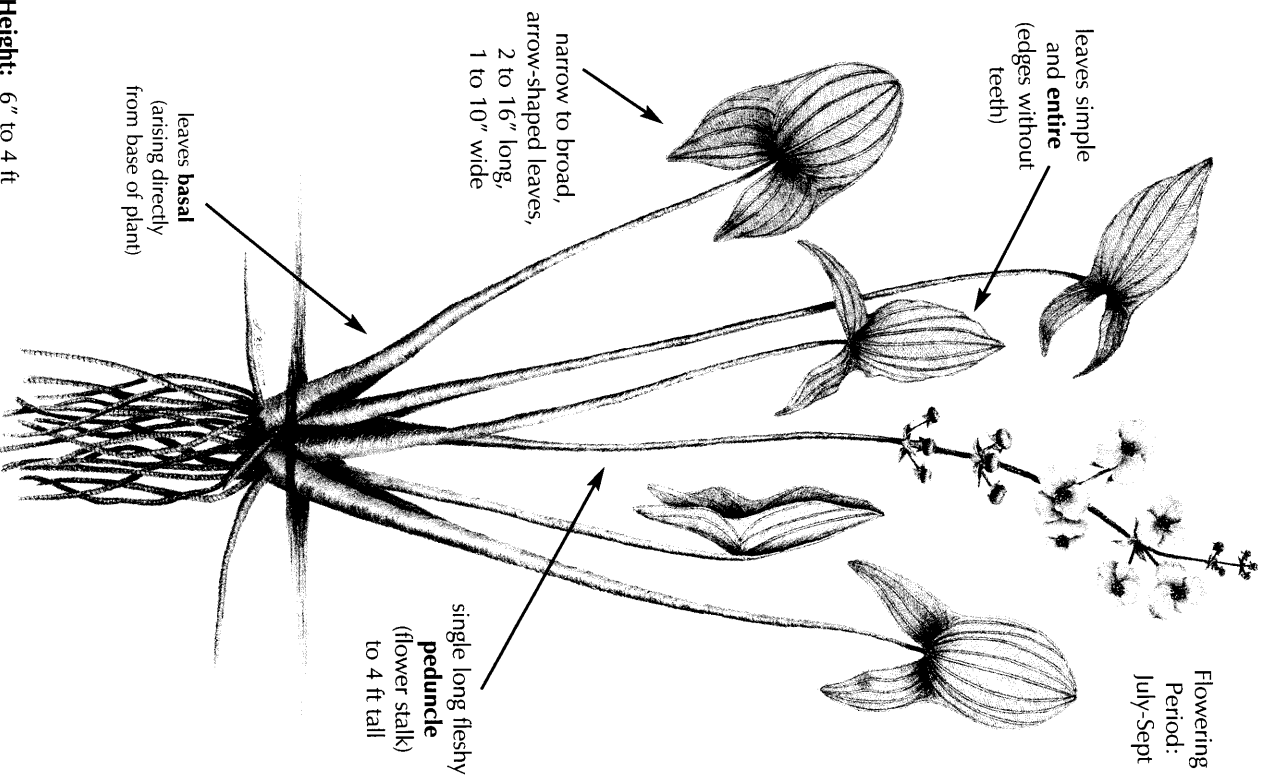


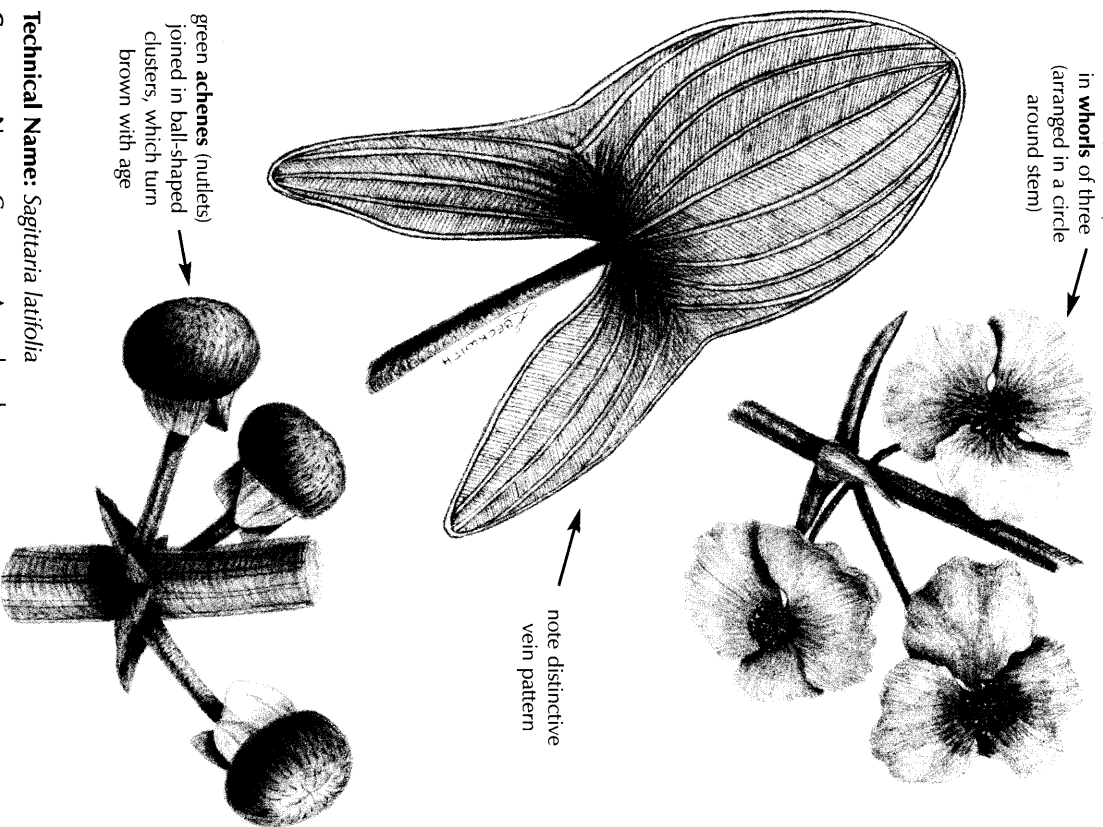
# Arrowhead

Flowering  
Period:  
July-Sept



**Height:** 6" to 4 ft  
**Habitat:** tidal fresh marshes  
inland marshes and borders of streams, lakes, and ponds

white 3-petaled flowers,  
1 to 1½" wide,  
in **whorls** of three  
(arranged in a circle  
around stem)



**Technical Name:** *Sagittaria latifolia*  
**Common Name:** Common Arrowhead  
**Family Name:** Alismataceae  
**Distinctive Characteristics:**  
General: emergent aquatic plant  
Flowers: white, 3-petaled flowers, 1 to 1½" wide, borne on single, long, fleshy peduncle  
Leaves: narrow to broad, arrow-shaped, 2 to 16" long, 1 to 10" wide, note distinctive vein pattern
