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Remote Learning Classroom Expectations

➤ Synchronous Learning

- We will meet daily from 9:40 - 10:05
 - Students will be engaged in mathematical discussions that will reinforce concepts presented asynchronously
 - Formal assessments (quizzes/tests) may be given during this time
 - If you are absent, you are responsible for the work you missed
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➤ Asynchronous Learning

- Each day students will have either an instructional video, classwork to complete or both
 - Students will be graded as follows for the completion of the asynchronous classwork:
 - 4 points - Students complete the classwork and post all necessary work to substantiate their answers on Google Classroom by the due date and time
 - 2 points - Students complete the classwork but no work is provided to substantiate their answers to Google Classroom by the due date and time
 - 0 points - Students failed to complete the classwork by the due date and time
 - Due to the fact that each assignment will be discussed during the “live” synchronous learning period, each assignment submitted late will receive:
 - 2 points if the assignment is submitted with work supporting solutions
 - 1 point if the assignment is submitted with no work supporting solutions
 - There may be times when formal assessments and/or extended classwork are necessary asynchronously and will be graded on a total point system.
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Quarter Grades

Each quarter grade is calculated by adding up all points “earned” and then dividing by the “maximum points possible”. Scores on all assignments and assessments will be available on Parent Portal.
