CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE CHARTER (approved by the BOE 8/29/22)

Purpose

The Committee is to review the monthly progress and to continue to prioritize capital project requests submitted by the Superintendent and the Director of Facilities for the Wappingers Central School District by the District's architects. The Capital Improvement Committee will assemble these requests into short and long-term capital asset project plans for the review and consideration by the entire Board of Education of the Wappingers Central School District. The main goal of this committee is to keep the Board of Education of the Wappingers Central School District and the local communities informed of the District's capital needs and the progress of the District's existing capital projects.

Capital Improvement Committee will consist of the following members:

- Superintendent of the Wappingers Central School District.
- Director of Facilities of the Wappingers Central School District.
- Assistant Superintendent for Administration and Information Systems.
- A board member serves as committee chair as appointed by Board President as per board policy 2250.
- Three Board of Education members of the Wappingers Central School District, and president as Ex Officio.
- The District-appointed architects for the Wappingers Central School District.
- Minimum of 2; up to 3 community members (selection made by the Superintendent and the Committee Chair). Duties and Responsibilities.
- To review monthly and provide feedback on prioritized capital project requests prepared by the District's Superintendent, District's Director of Facilities and the District's architects for the full board.
- To communicate to the full board the development of a Capital Plan that includes the annual priorities and a rolling five-year projection (updated annually) for consideration for inclusion in the annual budget.
- The Capital Plan will be prepared by the Superintendent, District's Director
 of Facilities, and the District's architects during construction to advise the
 committee of any change orders, planning changes, and any scheduling
 changes, in an effort to keep the entire Board of Education informed of the
 project's status.

- The Committee's meetings will be open to the public except to the extent that an executive session may be warranted under the provisions of the Open Meetings Law.
- Site visits may be conducted by any committee member permitting he/ she is accompanied by the Director of Facilities.
- Charter will be reviewed by the committee at the first July meeting of the school year.
