2. PNW School Safety Audits
 - a. KW Discussed the process for how PNW conducted school audits:
 - i. Reviewed safety concerns

 1. ex: how did they feel about emergency procedures
 - iii. Spent several hours inside the schools that were being audited
 - iv. Looking for issues with the facilities such as faulty door locks
 - v. Will provide lists of recommendations based upon the audit for the District to consider.

 - a. Current Policy (2019) indicates only Nurses can administer Narcan in our schools. KW: This can be problematic in after school activities, in other school districts we see narcan attached to AED locations as well as tourniquets and other first aid kits. KW has reached out to other school districts for other copies of policies.
 - b. What about buses and the availability of Narcan?
 - i. May be temperature stability issues (Below freezing temperatures is not recommended per Sgt Rahilly)
 - ii. Time is of the essence!
 - iii. May have resources available through the County, will speak with RF.
