

Long Term Development Committee Charter

Purpose/Charge

The Long Term Development Committee of the Wappingers Central School District is a standing advisory committee of the Board of Education that meets regularly to review and discuss ideas and long term recommendations that have an impact on the future operations of the district.

Composition/Membership

The Long Term Development Committee is composed of 3 board members voted upon by the Board of Education at the Reorganization meeting, the Assistant Superintendent for Compliance and Information Systems, the Director of Public Relations and Evaluations, up to 3 faculty members, up to 3 community members, and a clerical recorder as appointed by district administration. The Assistant Superintendent for Compliance and Information Systems serves as chairman on the Long Term Development Committee.

Recommendations are arrived through a process of full discussion in which each member has an equal voice and responsibility. When making recommendations to the Board, the committee does not have to reach agreement. In those cases, it will report the key points from multiple perspectives to the Board.

Meeting Notice

The committee shall meet at a minimum of three times annually.

Public notice of all Long Term Development Committee Meetings shall be posted on the District website not less than 72 hours prior to the meeting.

The District Clerk shall post the agenda and minutes from all meetings on the District's website.

Reporting

The Long Term Development Committee Chairperson shall provide the Board of Education with a report on its ideas and long term recommendations.

The Long Term Development Committee Charter shall be reviewed annually.
