Agenda: Introduction of Members, Review of Charter, Identification of topics the committee will review for the 2021-2022 school year

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 p.m. by Dr. Michelle Cardwell.

Each of the committee members introduced themselves as there are several new members on the committee this year.

Dr. Cardwell displayed the Charter for all members to see. The Charter was reviewed with all members to ensure all members understood the purpose of the committee.

The committee members had an opportunity to state what items they would like to see the committee review this year. After all topics were added to a list, the committee members voted on their top four topics. The topics with the most votes were selected for the committee to review this school year.

The topics that the committee will review this year include:

- 1) Review of Grades K-8 ELA and math curriculum and resources to ensure alignment with NYS Standards. This is an item of priority since Districts are expected to begin full implementation of the Standards in September 2022.
- 2) Review of selected ELA and Social Studies curricula for alignment with Board Policies.
- 3) Review of instructional strategies and programs (AIS/RtI/etc) being used to address academic achievement of students, inclusive of instructional practices and lessons learned over the past 18 months.
- 4) Review elective courses offered at the JHS and HS levels for continuity of resources, student interest level, and graduation pathways.
