5152.1 - Admission of Foreign Students	The committee reviewed the attorney feedback (below) related to a question about a reference to law that restricted the number of foreign exchange students a district can enroll from the same program.
	The regulations were modified. Current regulation 22 CFR 62.25 states: "Sponsors may not facilitate the enrollment of more than five exchange students in one school unless the school itself has requested,

	<ul> <li>in writing, the placement of more than five students from the sponsor." I would recommend leaving in the language of paragraph 4. It is the District's decision whether it would want to authorize a potential situation where one program could place more than five students.</li> <li>The second paragraph of the policy already states that the District can terminate its relationship with an exchange program when it would be in the best interests of the District. ## 3. New Business

Policy 5500 - Student Records	Assistant Superintendent Daren Lolkema requested revisions to the Student Records policy, specifically the section on directory information. The changes reflect a more limited policy with respect to the release of student information. The revision to the policy will only permit the district to release directory information when it pertains to yearbooks, honor roll lists, graduation programs, and playbills, without having to obtain parental consent.
	The committee also specified in the policy the ability of a classroom teacher or designated parent to compile class lists containing contact information, with parent permission, as a means of fostering community and communication between families.
	Mr. Lolkema also requested that Student ID be removed as a field that could be released as part of directory information. This is due to the Student ID being linked to financial information, such as the student account.
	A parent is able to opt out within 14 days of notice of the district. The policy also reflects that regardless if a parent opts out of directory information, a student would still be required to have a student ID badge.

It was unclear whether Section 467 of the Real Property Tax Law was related to STAR discounts. The district will gather information from the Business Office for the next meeting.
