Approval of Minutes

Energy Performance Project – Craig Rebecca of Ameresco

Craig Rebecca stated that Ameresco is still struggling with the ongoing issue with the inverters at *Brinckerhoff Elementary School*. The solar panels are producing electric power; however, Ameresco can't send the settings to Central Hudson for them to inspect it.

Ameresco has received all the approvals from the structural engineer for the redesign of *Fishkill Plains Elementary School.*

Capital Projects Update from John Sharkey Architecture

Capital Projects 2023 – Phase 1

All work has been completed except for the following:

- <u>Kitchen Hoods</u>
 - > The kitchen hoods will be done in the Summer of 2025.
- Fishkill Plains Elementary School
 - The HVAC chiller has been installed, but they need to wait for warmer weather to get it up and running.

- John Jay High School Roof
 - The punch list will be completed this week, finishing the brickwork was the last item.

Capital Project 2023 – Phase 2

- The bid opening was October 24, 2024.
- Low Bidders
 - Rhinebeck Architecture has reached out to the low bidders for the project, they have confirmed they are satisfied with their bids and scopes of work.
- Plans and Alternates
 - Ron will meet with the architect to review the plans and alternates. There is some minor additional work of transforming an area of the Wappingers Junior High Garage into a space for bus monitors to wait for their buses.
- The Main Garage Renovation Project
 - The temporary trailers for the Main Garage have been delivered to the site. Installation of power and fiber is scheduled to be completed by the end of the week.
 - Construction work for the Main Garage is set to begin in early December.
- Wappingers Junior High School Auditorium Sound System
 - Hudson Valley Audio/Visual has installed the projection screen. The auditorium will be completed for the November 18th Board Meeting.
- John Jay High School Press Box
 - Rhinebeck Architecture is working on the construction documents.
 - > This project will be included in the 2025 Capital Project Budget.

Wappingers Junior High Health Suite

• The Health Clinic renovations costs will be included in the 2025 Project. <u>Athletic Sound System Equipment</u>

- John Jay High School
 - Wires and speakers have been tested and are operational.
 - The district has to increase the power due to an upgraded cabinet delivered instead of the specified ones.
- Roy C. Ketcham High School
 - > The speaker installation is in progress and is awaiting a schedule.

Baseball/Softball Netting

- John Jay High School
 - > Drilling for the post is underway, followed by the concrete pouring.
- Roy C. Ketcham High School
 - > Drilling is scheduled to be begin on Monday, November 18th.

2025 Proposed Capital Project Vote

Dr. Bonk welcomed the principals and thanked them for joining the Capital Committee Meeting. He announced that a Capital Project has been put together and will be going out for voter approval in May 2025. These projects are being addressed as a result of the last Building Condition Survey Report. The Capital Committee wanted to share the plans with the principals and requested comments, pros/cons, and some feedback.

Dr. Bonk stressed the importance of transforming the school district to provide opportunities that have not been available to students due to space issues. The project proposes to put additions on both Junior High Schools. This will provide space for the sixth graders, who are currently in the elementary schools, to move to the middle schools for better learning and accelerated courses. This transfer would expose them to higher-level learning and thinking so that they can coexist along with seventh and eighth graders. The goal is to improve the middle school experience for the students, that will benefit them socially, emotionally and academically.

Dr. Bonk thanked the Capital Improvement Committee for supporting this project and all of their efforts that have gone into these plans.

Rhinebeck Architecture, John Sharkey – Proposed 2025 Capital Project

- The proposed 2025 Capital Project addresses areas for expansions, site and building improvements.
- A preliminary submission to the State Education Department will be done prior to the Vote.
- The project needs to be prioritized by what scopes should be designed and submitted first.
