Capital Projects Update from John Sharkey Architecture

Capital Projects 2023 – Phase 1

All work has been completed except for the following:

- Kitchen Hoods
 - > The kitchen hoods will be done in the Summer of 2025.
- Fishkill Plains Elementary School
 - ➤ The HVAC chiller has been installed, but they need to wait for warmer weather to complete connections and commission.
- John Jay High School Roof
 - Completed; punch list work is done.

Capital Project 2023 – Phase 2

- A contractor kick-off meeting was held this week.
- The next contractor meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, December 11th.
 The construction work on the garage is scheduled to begin on Thursday, December 12th.

➤ The temporary trailers for the Main Garage will be ready for staff to move in on Monday, December 9th.

• Wappingers Junior High School Auditorium Sound System

- ➤ Hudson Valley Audio/Visual work in the auditorium will be completed by December 5th. The delay was due to defective equipment that was delivered.
- > Training for the equipment is scheduled for Friday, December 6th.

• John Jay High School Press Box

- > Rhinebeck Architecture is working on the construction documents.
- > The renovation details still need to be provided.

• Wappingers Junior High Health Suite

> The Health Clinic renovation costs will be included in the 2025 Project.

• Athletic Sound System Equipment

- > John Jay High School
 - Speakers are operational and have been tested.
- ➤ Roy C. Ketcham High School
 - Installation of speakers is complete.
- Completion date is set for the end of December. Training will be scheduled when work is completed.

Baseball/Softball Netting

Project is on schedule

- John Jay High School
 - Pole delivery is scheduled for December 11th.
- Roy C. Ketcham High School
 - ➤ Pole delivery is scheduled for December 10th.

Van Wyck Junior High Steam Leaks

- There have been numerous steam leaks at Van Wyck Junior High School which is causing major damage and potential safety hazards. Ron Broas shared photos with the committee of the corroded and disintegrating heating system pipes.
- The committee agreed to include a new heating system project in Van Wyck Junior High School in the 2025 Vote.

Myers Corners Elementary School Student Drop-Off/Pick-Up Issues

- The committee agreed that the best way to address the traffic congestion at Myers Corners Elementary School is to hire a professional to conduct a "Feasible Traffic Design Study".
- Dutchess County is currently performing a study on the traffic conditions in that location.
- The district will do their own study for recommendations on improving safety measures for students, expanded parking and to alleviate traffic flow for arrivals and dismissals.
- The committee agreed to add this study in the 2025 Vote.

Server Rooms

• The committee identified all the server rooms that need cooling systems installed throughout the district.
