### Business Manager of IBEW Local Union 363 of the Hudson Valley, NY

Samuel Fratto was invited to give a presentation and discuss the benefits of a Project Labor Agreement for the next proposed Capital Project. A PLA is an agreement between the District and The Hudson Valley Building Trades. It guarantees local, highly skilled/trained workers with labor cost savings for the district.

These benefits include:

- Create apprenticeship and career opportunities in various Hudson Valley Trades for students seeking employment paths.
- Standardized rules and rates for all trades to ensure cost savings and a timely completion.
- Work hours flexibility by negotiation and payment for work outside standard hours, shifts in starting times allowed.

#### **Capital Projects Update from John Sharkey Architecture**

## Capital Project 2023 – Phase 2

 The Main Garage renovations are continuing. The floors are in rough shape and will have to be redone to get them level. A new water line needed to be run to the building.

#### Wappingers Junior High School Auditorium Sound System

Hudson Valley Audio/Visual has completed the installation of the sound system. A new cabinet will be built to house the system. The amplifiers aren't powerful enough, HVAV will be replacing them.

#### • John Jay High School Press Box

- Rhinebeck Architecture is still working on the documents and will be meeting with the Athletic Directors to get input.
- ➤ The John Jay Press Box Electric is overloaded, a new electric line has to be run.
- ➤ Daren Lolkema requested that fiber be run at the same time the new electric line is installed.

## Athletic Sound System Equipment

- > John Jay High School
  - The sound system will be completed within two weeks of the installation of the upgraded electric.
- > Roy C. Ketcham High School
  - Installation of speakers is complete.

## Myers Corners Elementary School Traffic Survey

- The final report will be completed in three weeks.
- The survey will be ready for the March 10, 2025 BOE Meeting.

## Purchase of Property Adjacent to Wappingers Junior High School

- Rhinebeck Architecture reviewed the feasibility study that was performed by Weston and Sampson on the property.
- Due to the environmental factors, it is not recommended to purchase the property.

- Eddy Sloshower made a motion to remove the acquisition of the property located at 15 Middlebush Road from the proposed May 2025 Capital Referendum, the agreement was unanimous.
- The Committee was in agreement to allocate the funds from the acquisition towards upgrading school restrooms.
- A SEQA Resolution will no longer be needed.

#### **Facilities Needs Assessment Summary**

John Sharkey explained the purpose of a "Facilities Needs Assessment Summary" required by the State Education Department. The summary must include a justification to expand the schools. Daren Lolkema wrote a letter explaining the educational need besides increased enrollment.

### **Address Temporary Sink Situation at Orchard View**

- ➤ There was a concern regarding a temporary sink at Orchard View with lack of water and drainage.
- ➤ The Facilities and Operations Department will install a water line and a condensate pump for proper function.
