Capital Projects Update from John Sharkey of Rhinebeck Architecture

Capital Projects 2023 – Phase 1

- <u>Fishkill Plains Elementary School</u> Contractor is continuing to do above ceiling work at night. The last two days, scans were being done on the roof to find the electrical conduit was buried in the wood deck of the roof.
- John Jay High School roof flashing will be completed when school is out.
- Wappingers Junior High Sidewalk Core testing results indicated there were issues with the cement. Three more cores will be pulled for testing. The sidewalks will need to be replaced. The entrance will need to be closed off during summer school until it has been completed.
- Roy C. Ketcham and John Jay High Schools Athletic Sound System Equipment wiring has been completed. The equipment may be delayed due to shipping delays.

Capital Project 2023 – Phase 2

The State Education Department still has not given any comments on the new project. The work will be planned for summer 2025.

<u>Wappingers Junior High Auditorium Sound System</u> – The equipment has been ordered, including a few approved items that were requested by the teachers.

<u>Wappinger Junior High Exterior Painting Project</u> – The contractor has completed the preparation work. The caulking and painting are scheduled for next week.

<u>John Jay Press Box</u> – The project is on hold and is waiting for approval.
