- John Jay High School Roof
  - ➤ The thru-wall flashing work is in progress.
- Wappingers Junior High School Sidewalks
  - ➤ The concrete sidewalk replacement has started.

#### • Roy C. Ketcham and John Jay High Schools' Athletic Sound System Equipment

> Starr Equipment provided the architect with a "proof of shipment certificate" for the athletic sound system equipment. If the equipment does not arrive by the first football game, Starr Equipment will provide the district with temporary equipment.
