**\*With all supplies, please get the BRAND names if listed.\***

**\*There is a huge difference in quality.\***

**Required:**

- ★ 3 Sturdy **Plastic** folders (1 **RED** for 'Writing', 1 **BLUE** for 'Desk', 1 **Any Color** for 'Home/School' \*You can label them with child's name and subject if you like!! \*No cardboard folders - they don't last.
- ★ 15-20 Ticonderoga sharpened pencils
- ★ 2 boxes of 8, 16, or 24 Crayola crayons (**NO boxes of 48**, please get standard size and color)
- ★ 2 large erasers (pink or white - **white is best!**)
- ★ 1 box of Crayola fat-tipped markers
- ★ 8 thin-tipped Expo dry erase markers
- ★ 2 **BIG Elmer's** Glue Sticks
- ★ 12 Elmer's Glue Sticks
- ★ 1 pair of scissors (Fiskars)
- ★ 1 small pencil sharpener
- ★ 1 set of **GOOD QUALITY** headphones, not earbuds. (With daily use the sturdier, the better.)
- ★ pencil box for desk supplies
- ★ 1 box of tissues
- ★ 1 of box "ziploc" baggies (any brand):
