

- 4. Then go on the grass line.

Letter Formation for Q


q is a plane line round letter.

It starts on the (plane line)...

Remember that q is the chicken letter so in the end it wants to point up to its "buddy" u.

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- 1. Point to the plane line.
- Trace-back and go down to the grass-line around, back to the plane line.
- 3. Trace back down to the worm line,
- 4. and point up to his "buddy" u.



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
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
