Draw a Bluebird!





Step 1

Start by drawing the eye—a little round circle and a dot.


Step 2


Draw a beak in front of the eye. There are many different beak shapes. This beak is for a bird who eats seeds.

Step 3

From the top of the beak, draw a curving line up over the eye.







Step 4


From the bottom of the beak, draw a line down for the throat. Then draw a line across the neck.

Step 5

Next, draw the chest with a long, curving line down to where the tail will start. Then draw a straighter line for the back.

Step 6

Draw the wing with three curved lines. One line goes from the middle of the neck to the middle of the back. Another line goes from the same place on the neck down to the tip of the body. The last line curves between the other two lines.



Step 7

Add feathers with little lines that curve at the end like the letter "J." Draw short feathers in the top part of the wing. Draw longer feathers in the bottom section.




Step 8

Draw a tail slanting down from the back of the body. This bird has a long, thin tail.

Step 9

Two bent lines make a bird's leg. Draw one leg in front of the other. The toes are skinny loops—three in front and one in back. Draw tiny claws on the ends.
