yo	nosotros
tú	vosotros
él/ella/Ud	ellos/ellas/Uds

El verbo tener = to have

Yo tengo	I have	Nosotros/Nosotras tenemos	We have
Tú tienes	You (familiar) have	Vosotros/Vosotras tenéis	You all (in Spain) have
Él, Ella, Usted tiene	He, She has You (formal) have	Ellos, Ellas, Ustedes tienen	They (m), They (f), You all have

Tener is irregular for two reasons:

1. the "yo" form ends in -go
2. the "tú, él, ella, usted" and "ellos, ellas ustedes" forms have the stem change e → ie
