## 2020-2021 Remote Learning Syllabus

#### Our goals this year:

This course is intended to accomplish a number of goals:

- To meet the standards for the Mathematics 8 Common Core curriculum. Topics to be covered include: Solving Equations, Number Systems, Functions, Graphing and Statistics.
- To prepare for the NYS Mathematics Exam to be given in Spring 2021 and the Math 8 Final Exam administered in June 2021.
- To develop or enhance a system of organization and self-discipline.

#### Grading:

Grading in the digital classroom will be based on effort and demonstration of concept mastery.

- Assignments 50% of each quarter during remote learning.
- Assessments Quizzes and tests will count together as 50% of each quarter during remote learning.
- Incompletes and Absences- Missed work must be completed. No grades will be issued until all back work is completed.

### <u>Requirements:</u>

- 1. Attendance is important. Any work missed due to an absence is the students' responsibility.
- 2. Each student is to have a binder with lined paper (or a notebook) to put in the binder and pencils. Students should also have access to graph paper. A scientific calculator is recommended but not required, there are online versions of the scientific calculator that will be available on Google Classroom.
- 3. There will be written math practice for every topic. This work will help students review and reinforce the topic(s) covered. If no written homework is assigned, the student should review notes, self-quiz, etc.
