The first draft of the <u>Superintendent's Recommended Budget</u> is now posted on our website. This is the first draft that typically is presented to the Board of Education during the month of March. It is important to note that revisions and changes are still occurring as we await our final State Aid in April. Our goal is to ensure a balanced budget without going over the allowable tax cap. Once again, we have been fortunate that Wappingers has never requested to levy more taxes than the cap allows. The proposed first draft of the budget for the 2019–2020 school year maintains all educational opportunities and programs for our students. As we approach New York State testing for students in grades 3-8, our goal is to increase the level of student participation. You may have noticed that we continue to offer presentations regarding the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) throughout the District. Assistant Superintendent Daren Lolkema has been providing these presentations and sharing information related to ESSA as it is related to New York State testing as well as graduation rates.
