**Chromebook Distribution Message from District Office:
Good Morning Wappingers CSD Families,**

As you may be aware, all 7th & 8th grade Students in our 2 public junior high schools will be receiving a Chromebook as part of our new 1:1 Chromebook initiative for the 2021-2022 school year and beyond.

The purpose of this message is to let you know our plan for distributing these devices to our 8th grade students and to any 7th grade student who could not attend the designated distribution dates and has not yet received a device.

We are intending to distribute these devices to our students beginning the week of September 13th. Prior to distribution, we will be sending our students home with a Chromebook Use / Agreement Form on the first day of school. The form your child receives will have a place for both you and your child to sign. Once signed, your child will be asked to bring the form back to school as soon as possible. Students will not receive a Chromebook if we do not receive your signed Agreement Forms.

We hope that these devices will become an integral part of their educational experience in Wappingers. Our ability to continue this 1:1 program will be dependent on the success our students have with this initiative. If all goes well, Students in grades 7 & 8 will be eligible to borrow a Chromebook from the District via this 1:1 program for the duration of their enrollment with the District.

Please note: we have a few students who still have Chromebooks from last school year that need to be returned to the school. These Chromebooks are now

inactive and unable to use. Please return these Chromebooks otherwise you will not receive a new Chromebook.
