Mathematics/Science Grade 7 Honors Program

- Different textbook
- Different curriculum
- 7th and 8th grade topics in one year
- Pacing is accelerated
- More detailed and more complicated material
- No review of the 6th grade
- Multiple late assignments will result in a reevaluation of the student's placement
- No extra credit work is available
- Independent application of previously taught material
- Leads to high school Regents courses and NYS Regents exams for credit in grade 8
- There are guidelines to remain in the program, including but not limited to maintaining an 85% or higher average.

ELA/Social Studies Grade 7 Honors Program

- More complex and challenging classwork, homework, projects and tests
- Different final exam
- More independent, research-based projects
- Greater emphasis on independent reading/writing, including essays and short answer responses
- Multiple late assignments will result in a reevaluation of the student's placement
- No extra credit work is available
- Independent application of previously taught material
- Pacing is accelerated, content enriched
- Students will be expected to participate in class discussions on a regular basis
- Additional Summer Reading assignment for ELA
- There are guidelines to remain in the program, including but not limited to maintaining an 85% or higher average.
