For the past few years, the Wappingers Central School District has used i-Ready to support instruction in reading and math for students in grades K-8. The District will continue to use i-Ready for the 2020-2021 school year. i-Ready is an online program for reading and math that will help your child's teacher to determine each student's academic needs, personalize learning, and if needed, monitor progress throughout the school year.

i-Ready consists of two parts: Diagnostic and Personalized Online Instruction. The Diagnostic is an adaptive assessment that adjusts questions based on each student's needs. Each item a student sees is individualized based on their answer to the previous question. i-Ready Personalized Instruction will provide students with access to online lessons based on their skill level and academic needs.

Your child can access i-Ready at <https://login.i-ready.com/>. They will need their username and password and can get this information from their child's teacher. Once your child logs in to i-Ready, they will be prompted to take the Diagnostic prior to lessons being assigned.
