

Driver Education COVID Safety Precautions for Behind-the-Wheel (BTW) Instruction

ADA will follow all NYS DMV and Board of Health guidelines by enforcing the following guidelines:

- ADA is now providing two program options for either 3 or 4 students per car
- All drivers and students will be required to wear masks while in the cars. Gloves are optional.
 - Students are responsible for bringing their own masks and/or gloves.
- ADA will supply cleaning wipes for students to wipe down common areas in the car, such as the steering wheel, inside mirrors, door handles, locks, and seatbelts.
- Students will have their temperatures taken each day before entering the car.
- No student or driver will be allowed in the car if they have a fever, and/or are showing signs of feeling ill. If someone is displaying symptoms or feeling sick, they will be asked to provide test results indicating that they are well and free from the Covid-19 virus before they may return.
- Car windows will remain cracked or open whenever possible for better circulation of fresh air.
- ADA agrees to waive make-up fees if prolonged absences are due to Covid-19.
- Parents will be required to sign a waiver, as part of the registration process, stating that they are aware of the potential risks.
