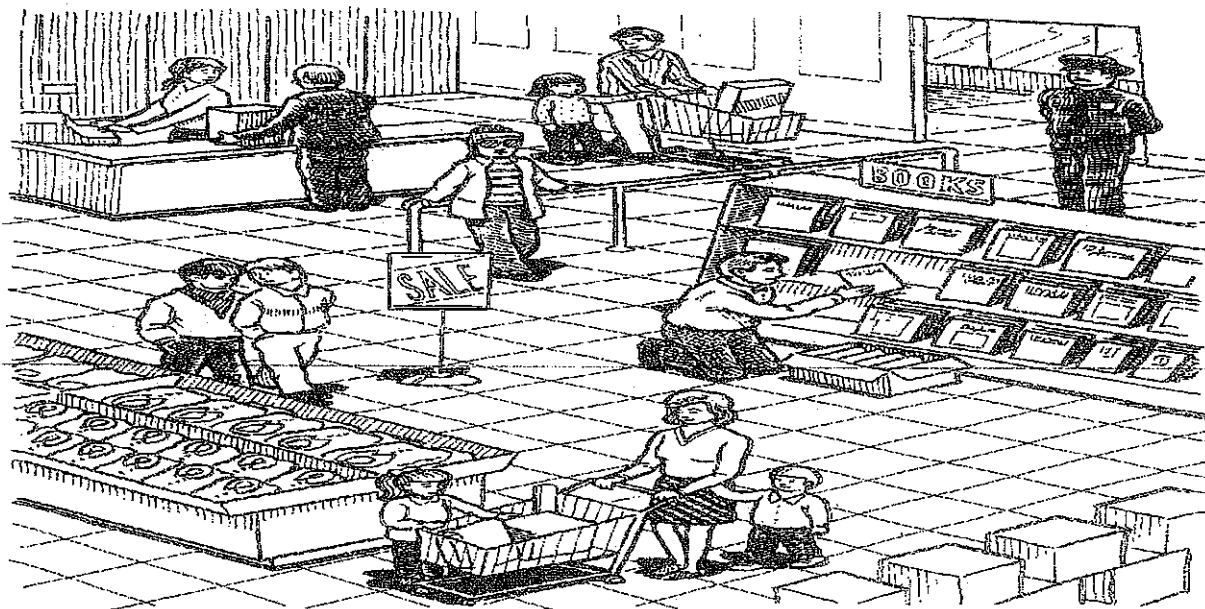

1. Discuss the Activity Sheet about people whom they would approach if they were lost in a store.



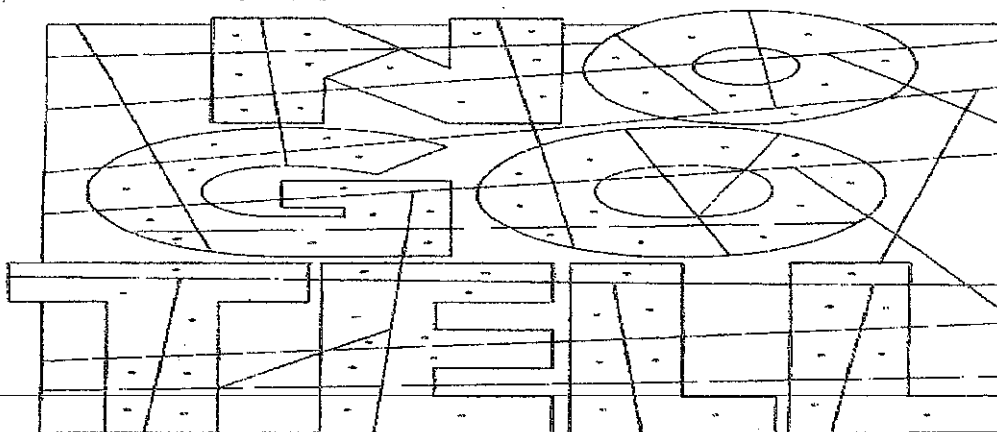
Directions: Have the children color in the pictures of people whom they would approach if they were lost in a store.
