Discuss rules if you are home alone.

Make sure you have an emergency ID card with you.

Know how to call 911, call long distance, use a pay telephone, make a collect call, and use a cell phone.

Review common tricks such as: offers, animals, emergency, asking for help, friend, bad child, flattery, open the door, secret, and networking. Remember the Buddy System, Check First, and NO, GO, TELL rules are keys to avoiding these tricks and staying safe.

Set ground rules and "contracts" with parents to keep safe.
