

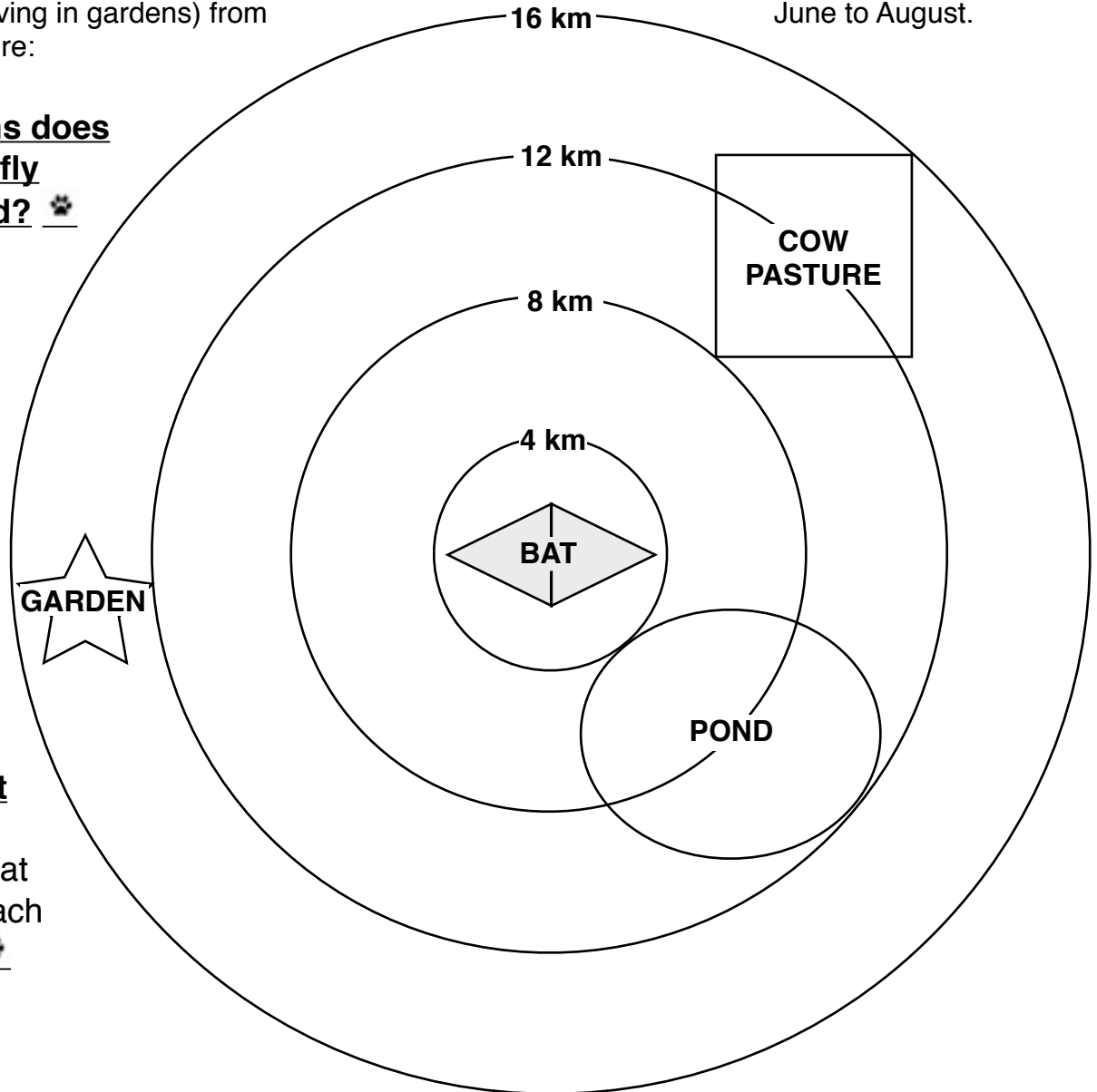
**Math Problem of the Week #15**

Hello Animal Explorers,

Wow, last weeks question was really hard wasn't it! There are many different kinds of bats in Europe. The Greater Horseshoe Bat eats insects like Crane flies (which live by ponds) from August to September, Dung Beetles (which like cow pastures) from April to June, and Moths (living in gardens) from June to August. Looking at the picture:

**1. Which months does the bat need to fly farthest for food? 🐾**

**2. If a bat flew to the closest edge of the cow pasture for 3 nights and the closest edge of the pond for the rest of the week, how far would it have traveled? (remember the bat must fly home each morning.) 🐾 🐾 🐾**
