

2020-2021 K-6 Humanities Curriculum Overview for Hybrid/Remote Learning

The teaching of reading and writing in the elementary program at the Wappingers Central School District follows the philosophies and practices of the Reading and Writing Project at Teachers College, which is led by Lucy Calkins. Our District's primary resources for teachers are the <u>Units of Study for Teaching Reading</u> and the <u>Units of Study for Teaching Writing</u>, written by Lucy Calkins and her colleagues from the Reading and Writing Project.

Our District's primary resource for Social Studies is the curriculum created and distributed by Putnam/Northern Westchester BOCES, the Wappingers Central School District Integrated Technology Enhanced Units, and the Inquiry Units found on EngageNY.
