Dear Parent or Guardian,

"Open House" is scheduled this year for Wednesday, September 28, from 7-9 pm. At "Open House" you will have opportunities to meet your children's teachers and learn more about the courses they will taking, including its syllabi, grading and homework policies, textbooks and/or resources used, special supplies, contact information, teacher webpages and extra help. I anticipate a big turnout and, therefore, encourage parents to arrive early to avoid parking delays and missing any part of the event. During "Open House" you will follow your children's schedules while changing classes approximately every ten minutes. More information to follow as we get closer to September 28. "Open House" is for parents only!

The updated District Code of Behavior and Student Handbook will be available on-line in the near future. It is important that both documents be reviewed in detail with your children. This is to help ensure their successful transition to Van Wyck. I also attached copies of the Van Wyck Dress Code to this opening letter for your convenience. I am confident in knowing that our skilled, talented and knowledgeable staff will be there to ensure that all children successfully transition to Van Wyck and enjoy their experiences here.
