Middle School SAT Testing Guide

Roy C. Ketcham Test Center ID: 33958

Middle school students who qualify are taking the SAT through the John's Hopkins Center for Talented Youth (CTY) will typically take the test in December, January, or March. Students taking the SATs after the Jan. 21st testing, will not have their scores available for Summer Program eligibility.

All testing in Wappingers takes place at Roy C. Ketcham High School. Students are permitted to bring a snack and beverage for consumption during the ten minute break. If students bring a cell phone, they must turn off the phone and give it to the proctor when they enter the testing room. Under no circumstances may a student use a cell phone at any time during testing or breaks. Any student communicating via cell phone or text messaging from 7:15 AM until 12:45 PM will be excused from testing. If students need to communicate with someone, they must speak with their room proctor who will direct them to Ms. McCaffrey for assistance. Students must take all sections once admitted. If they have to leave during testing for any reason, all sections of the test are invalidated.

Testing details

Students should arrive at Ketcham at 7:15 AM. Students should bring #2 pencils, a calculator, and a snack to be eaten during the morning break time. 7th/8th grade students are not required to bring a photo ID but are to bring their official admission paperwork from College Board. When students arrive they will be asked to remain in the Ketcham main lobby until the announcement is made for students to go to their assigned rooms. Room assignments are posted on test morning in the Ketcham lobby. Parents are welcome in the Ketcham lobby prior to testing but may not accompany students to the testing room.

Notes for students with testing accommodations

If a student has a 504 or IEP through a Wappingers or area school, they are not automatically eligible for testing accommodations on College Board tests. There is a separate process that takes a minimum of seven weeks to get approval for testing accommodations.
