Lessons and Practice

Individual Instrument lessons will be given once in a 6-day cycle. Lesson schedules will be given out at the beginning of each semester. For lessons, make sure you:

1. Notify your classroom teacher of your scheduled lesson. If you have a major test or a special lab, you may be excused from lessons provided you notify Mrs. Daniels prior to the lesson. Many times, quizzes and labs can be taken at an alternate time.
2. Come prepared - practice assigned lesson, positive attitude, ready to play.
3. Come organized with your instrument, pencil, folder with lesson book and music.
4. If you miss a lesson, **you are responsible for all material missed**. Please be sure to get your assignment from another student or ask Mrs. Daniels. **Failure to attend a lesson will result in a grade of a zero for that lesson, unless excused.**

If you have more than one missed lesson in a quarter you will receive a make-up assignment to be completed through the Band 7 Google Classroom.

If you miss a lesson because you are absent from school you will **not** be penalized for missing the lesson.

BAND REHEARSALS

The great part about learning an instrument is coming together with everyone else in a large ensemble setting.

Learning an instrument can be challenging and requires hard work, dedication and most importantly

PRACTICE!

Be considerate of your classmates and arrive to rehearsal:

1. on time
2. prepared - having practiced your band music!
3. organized with instrument, folder with music and a pencil
4. with a positive attitude.

Every student must be in the room when the bell rings and ready to play on stage three minutes after the bell.

INSTRUMENT STORAGE

On Band and Lesson Days, Instruments may be placed in the instrument storage rooms next to the stage. Instruments must go **HOME** at the end of the day. This area is **NOT** a secure area outside of the school day.

ASSESSMENT

Student evaluation is reflected in the music grade, a composite of a student's participation and achievement in assignments and assessments. The grade may be derived from objective and subjective teacher evaluations and observations, including the student's demonstration of criteria-based skills and techniques in performance and homework assignments.

Attendance at Concerts is **MANDATORY**. Remember, each member of this ensemble is important. Everyone needs to contribute 100% for a successful experience. The Winter Concert is considered a mid-term exam and the Spring Concert is considered a final exam. If either concert is missed for whatever reason, a make-up assignment must be done.
