**Materials** - Graphing calculators will be used often in this course, however, there will be certain times when calculators will not be allowed. This includes the final exam.

If you are interested in purchasing your own graphing calculator (which I highly suggest) I recommend the TI-84 Plus CE as it is the most user friendly. There are also graphing calculator applications available for smartphones. I recommend Calculate84 which is a free app available for most devices.

All students should have some sort of notebook to hold their math notes and handouts.

**Assignments** – There will be an assignment almost every day which will be posted on Google Classroom. All assignments will be due by 7am the following class day and will be worth 2 points based on effort. *Late assignments can be made up for 1 point only if all work is shown.*

**Graded Assignments** – Graded Assignments will occasionally be assigned and posted on Google Classroom. These assignments can be worth up to 45 points. *Graded assignments will be accepted late, however, several points will be deducted for each day it is past due.*

**Quizzes/Tests** - Quizzes will be worth anywhere from 5 to 45 points each. Quizzes can be expected at least once a week. There *may* be an exam every two or three weeks. These exams will be announced in advance. If there is an absence on the day of a quiz or test the students are expected to take the exam on the day that they return to school. Tests typically range from 45 to 100 points.

**Midterm/Final Exams** – There is no midterm exam for this course. The DCC final will cover topics which are part of the DCC MAT 185 curriculum. The use of a calculator is not allowed on the final exam. The final exam will count towards 20% of the final grade for the course.

**Computing Averages** - A student can determine their average at any time by adding the points they have earned and dividing by the total number of points which they could have earned. Students can also check their average on Google Classroom.

**Extra Help** - I am available for extra help during the school day, specifically periods 1, 5 & 8. If a student needs to stay after school for extra help, they may ask for available times. Students should feel free to stop by whenever they have any questions.
