Supplies:

1. **3-Ring Binder (2 in):** It is extremely important to take notes and to keep those notes organized. To teach these skills I am requiring each student to have a 3-ring binder for the exclusive use of Algebra Honors.
2. **Dividers**
3. **Looseleaf Paper**
4. **Writing Utensils**
5. **Calculator:** Graphing calculators will be used daily in this course and will be provided for classroom use only. If you are interested in purchasing your own graphing calculator (which I highly suggest) I recommend the TI-84 Plus CE as it is the most user friendly and is the same as the calculator we are using in class. There are also graphing calculator applications available for smartphones. I recommend "calculator x" which is a free app available for most devices.

Assignments – There will be an assignment almost every day which will be posted on Google Classroom. All assignments will be due by 7am the following class day and will be worth up to 2 points based on effort. *Late assignments can be made up for 1 point only if all work is shown.*

Graded Assignments – Graded Assignments will occasionally be assigned and posted on Google Classroom. These assignments can be worth up to 45 points. *Graded assignments will be accepted late, however, points will be deducted for each day it is past due.*

Quizzes/Tests - Quizzes will be worth anywhere from 5 to 45 points each. Quizzes can be expected at least once a week. There *may* be an exam every two or three weeks. These exams will be announced in advance. If there is an absence on the day of a quiz or test the students are expected to take the exam on the day that they return to school. Tests typically range from 45 to 100 points.

Midterm/Final Exams - Should the decision be made that there will be a midterm and/or a final exam students will be notified well in advance of the date for them to adequately prepare for that exam.

Passing the Algebra 1 Regents is a Graduation Requirement. The exam will be Tuesday, June 4th at 7:50am.

Averages – Averages are updated daily and can be viewed on Google Classroom and on Parent Portal.

Extra Help - I am available for extra help during the school day, specifically periods 4 & 6. If a student needs to stay before or after school for extra help, they may ask for available dates and times.
